Policy TC8	Broadly supportive however consideration should be given to the direction of traffic movements. Currently it is not possible to turn right from Alcester Road on to Grove Road. This forces all traffic along Greenhill Street in order for them to turn Right into Rother Street; including through traffic. During the MOP traffic is permitted to turn right into Grove Road from Alcester Road, allowing this movement generally could assist in making Rother Street a more attractive area for investment.
