It's taken months of debate and weeks of writing, but the emerging Neighbourhood Plan is ready for your inspection at this weekend's Open Days at the Town Hall.

A team of residents have come up with a set of proposals for policies they feel has yours and Stratford's best interests at heart and, this weekend, they need your help to check they're on the right track by coming along to the Open Days at the Town Hall, looking at the details, filling in a questionnaire and giving your feedback. It's open on Sunday 30 June, 11 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Monday 1st July, 1 p.m. - 8 p.m.

Together, we can make Stratford an even better place.

The finished plan will give residents the legal power to help shape Stratford for the next twenty years in key areas such as housing, jobs, town centre improvements, infrastructure, leisure and our fantastic green spaces.
